Eligibility: Students who have received a Division I (gold medal) rating in the HMTA Piano Contest.

Repertoire: One or two (contrasting) compositions from the standard "classical" piano literature.

Event Rules:

1. Entrants may not repeat HMTA Piano Contest repertoire.
2. No arrangements or transcriptions are allowed.
3. Maximum performance time is 7 minutes.
4. All music must be memorized.
5. An original score without identifying marks, with measures numbered, must be provided for the judge. Photocopies that meet the requirements of Standing Rule #10 must be submitted to the Chair for approval prior to the event.
6. The 1st place winners must perform at the Winners' Recital.

Setting: Small audience: performances are open to the public

Dress Code: Formal Attire

Awards: \$2000 in scholarships
Judges will decide upon 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place winners.
Their decision will be final.
No critiques will be given.
BMJPF Scholarships will be awarded at the recital.

Recital Location: Nat Gilley Recital Hall

Registration: Invitation and form to be sent to Piano Contest (Division I) students and their teachers. Deadline: April HMTA meeting.
Use form F4.

Fee: Paid by Sherman Clay Pianos.
