Eligibility: Pre-K - 12th Grade, Collegiate, Adult Hobbyist
This event is open to students of HMTA and non-HMTA teachers, without discrepancy in the registration fee.

Age Divisions:

1. ELEMENTARY:	Pre-K through Grade 5
2. JUNIOR:	Grades 6 through 8
3. SENIOR:	Grades 9 through 12
4. COLLEGIATE:	Enrolled in a college or university
5. ADULT HOBBYIST:	Non-professional, age 19 and above

Ensemble Categories:

CHAMBER MUSIC: Two or more performers with equal parts (no solo with accompaniment), i.e. string trios, quartets, piano trios, brass quintets, woodwind quartets, etc.

INSTRUMENTAL ENSEMBLES: All or most of the instruments are of the same design. i.e. trombone quartets, violin trios, etc. (this does not include piano ensembles).

PIANO ENSEMBLES: One piano 4-hands, 6-hands, 8-hands, two piano ensembles (duos), and double piano concertos.

VOCAL ENSEMBLES: Two or more voices (only one person to a line). Accompanists need not be in the same age division.

CHAMBER MUSIC CONCERTOS: i.e. Symphonie Concertante, triple concertos, etc. Accompanists need not be in the same age division.

Repertoire Requirement:

1. Compositions may be any standard work of any period.
No abridged or simplified works are allowed, except with approval of Contest Chair.
2. Time limitations: Pieces should not be less than 2 minutes, and not exceed 15 minutes.
