Purpose: To be part of an informed body of students gaining a wider musical experience than is usually afforded in private music study, with recognition for achievement in various phases of musical education and activity.

Eligibility: Pre-K - 12 Grade, and Post-12 (up to age 26)

Registration: Enrollment forms for teachers whose students were previously enrolled as SA members will be mailed out in September. New teachers should use the form that is available in the back of the HMTA yearbook. Although there is no official deadline, a student must be registered as an SA Member at least one month prior to an SA event. For the first SA event (Fall Theory Test), SA registration must be turned in by September 26, 2007. Use form F14.

Fee: HMTA teachers can now enroll online at TMTA.org but copy of form and fee must be mailed to local SA Chair
HMTA charges \$10 per student for online and paper registration
If a student participated in an SA event without first registering in SA the following penalty will be imposed (subject to increase by TMTA):
Teacher: \$50 and \$15 (processing fee)
Student: \$9 and \$8 (late fee)
